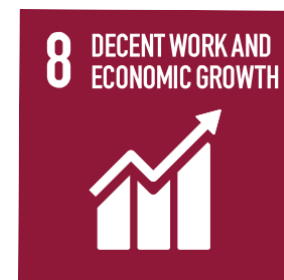

Rethinking the role of plastics

Freightways is committed to reducing the amount of virgin plastics we use and ensuring the rest are reusable, recyclable or compostable. Here's what we're doing to achieve this by 2025.



Partnering with Love NZ Soft Plastic Recycling Scheme



Moving freight consolidation bags from single use to reusable and recyclable



Satchels made from a minimum of 80% NZ-sourced plastic waste



Working with New Zealand Government Agencies as part of the 'Broader Outcomes Initiative' to introduce bio-based satchels (manufactured from plant waste) in 2021



Trialing bio-based packaging that is recyclable or compostable



Our Enviro360 allows you to upcycle your used courier packs into sustainable building materials



Giving you full visibility of your emissions

Any New Zealand Couriers customer using Prepaid, Charge Label or Manifest tickets can get a Toitū verified report of emissions for your courier transport.

Your report gives detail on your emissions for greater transparency and informed decision making.

The methodology behind this has been independently verified by Toitū Envirocare. The data is suitable for use in an ISO 14064-1:2018 compliant inventory.

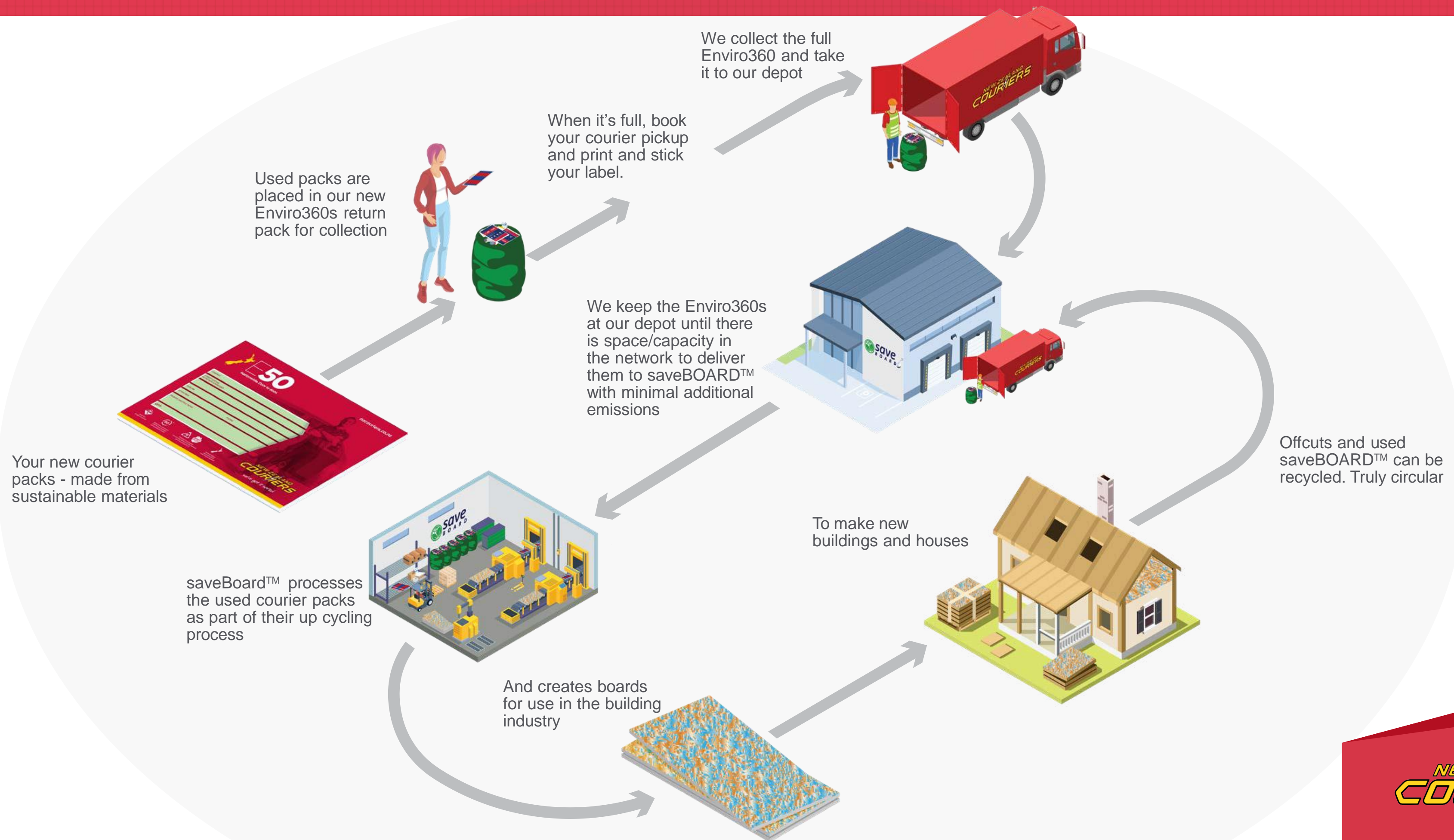
What's saveBOARD?

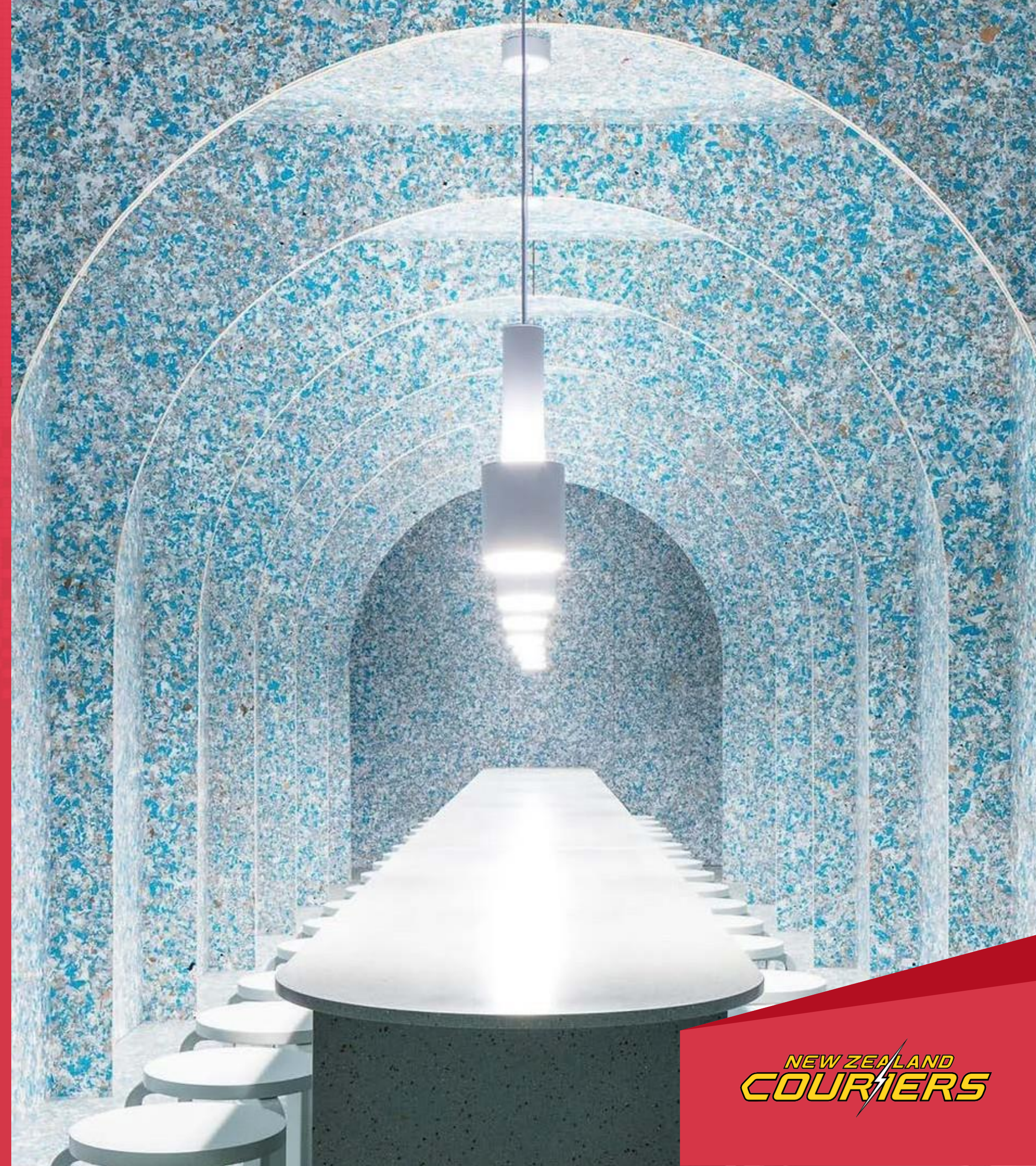
